  - How much did you understand?
  - If not saved, do you know enough to receive Jesus Christ as Savior?
- 6. Does learning more about what Christ has done for you in saving you from sin, judgment, hell and the lake of fire make salvation more precious to you?
  - How does knowing more make you feel about God and Jesus and your daily relationship to the Lord?
- 7. How does understanding God's hatred of sin and His love for you change the way you feel about sin, those not yet 'born again' by faith in Christ and this world system at enmity with Him and the gospel?
